Auditions will be held for the Missoula Children's Theatre (MCT) production of SLEEPING BEAUTY Monday, February 22, 2010 at the Nelle Black Westgate Auditorium in Canton from 4:00 PM to 6:00 PM. All those auditioning should arrive at 3:45 PM to register and plan to stay for the full two hours. Some of the cast members will be asked to stay for a rehearsal immediately following the auditions.

Among the roles to be cast are Sleeping Beauty, Scarella, Madame Butterfly, the King, the Queen, Spot, Fairies, Trolls, Palace Attendants and Caterpillars. Students in Kindergarten through 12th grade are encouraged to audition. No advance preparation is necessary. Assistant Directors will also be cast to aid in rehearsals throughout the week, and to take on essential backstage responsibilities.

The Missoula Children's Theatre touring productions are complete with costumes, scenery, props and makeup. The MCT Tour Actor/Directors will conduct rehearsals throughout the week from 4:00 pm to 8:30 PM each day. There is no fee to participate in the residency.

SLEEPING BEAUTY will be presented on Friday February 26 at 7:00PM and Saturday, February 27 as 11:00AM at the Nelle Black Westgate Auditorium in the Canton High School. Tickets for these performances are \$6.00 and can be purchased at the door.
