Endless Mountain Digital Film Festival – Deadline Extended!!

The Bradford County Regional Arts Council has extended the deadline for film submission for the third Endless Mountains Digital Film Festival. Filmmakers of all ages are invited to submit short digital films to the Arts Council by noon on June 5, 2009. Winning submissions will be screened at participating theatres throughout the Endless Mountains region. Monetary prizes will be awarded.

The Endless Mountains Film Festival was created in 2006 **“to promote and encourage the creative and pioneering spirit of people working in the digital arts.”** Films will be viewed by a panel of expert judges who will make their decisions based on originality, creativity, and technical skills demonstrated by the filmmaker. Films will be entered in either of two categories based on the age of the filmmaker: 12 and Under or Teen/Adult.

The Festival Trophy is named the Stuart Grasberg Award. Stuart grew up in Towanda and produced programs for PBS television in Charlotte, North Carolina.
