Box of Light Theatre Camps Return to the Keystone Theatre

Box Of Light Theatre will be bringing some high kicking, game playing, robot making summer camps to Towanda's Keystone Theatre in July. From Kung Fu Film to Robotics, from Claymation to Brain Games for Pre-Schoolers, the summer camps, now in their fifth year are being offered from July 20-24.

In Kung Fu Film, Samantha Phillips, whose FightTrix company teaches stage combat for stage and film, will teach the Towanda students to choreograph, film and edit their own fight scenes. In the spirit of good (meaning bad) Kung Fu films, the dialog will be added later and slightly out of synch with the actors' lips. According to Phillips, "the film is destined to be a classic."

New to Box Of Light's summer offerings will be a week of classes for pre-school aged children. The Brain Games for Pre-Schoolers camp will use interactive stories, games and creative dramatics to work on memory, coordination and communication skills. Teacher Rand Whipple says that the hour-long classes are fun for the kids and will give parents new ideas for preparing their children for kindergarten and first grade.

Students will be able to create and program their very own androids in Robotics Camp and create their own movies in Claymation Camp. Both camps allow students to move at their own pace and provide additional challenges for returning students.
